## NBHA Member:

The North Dakota NBHA State Championships will be held August 31 and September 1, 2019 in Valley City, ND at the North Dakota Winter Show Facility. **Contestants may NOT arrive on the grounds prior to 3:00 Friday!**

## Qualifications:

Current members that have competed in three district barrel races between January 1, 2019 and August 30, 2019 may enter. Please contact **Lois at 701-652-2413 or 701-307-0467** if you are unsure of your eligibility.

## Entry Instructions:

Entry Form is included in this packet. Please use one form per person and be sure to include all fees with **checks made payable to ND NBHA. Mail to: Connie Buck, 1591 104<sup>th</sup> St SE; Minot, ND 58701. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 23<sup>rd</sup>** to ensure arrival prior to the event. Your entry will not be valid until payment is received. Indicate on the entry form if you DO NOT want your name listed on the website. Late entries will be accepted until 11:00am on Saturday, August 31<sup>st</sup> for State Championships with additional late fees applied. DO NOT MAIL LATE ENTRIES. Entry information and forms will be posted at [www.nd04.com](http://www.nd04.com), with pre-entry draw and exhibition list will be posted on Thursday, August 29<sup>th</sup>.

## Championship Rules:

1. All State Champions will be determined from the average. The Open and Youth classes will be a 4D; the Senior class will be a 3D. A 4D average will be determined by adding the fast time of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> go's to determine the time brackets for 1-D. To this, 1 second will be added for the 2-D, 2 seconds for the 3-D and 4 seconds for the 4-D. A 3D average will be determined by adding the fast time of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> go's to determine the time brackets for the 1-D. To this, 2 seconds will be added for the 2-D and 4 seconds will be added for the 3-D.
2. NBHA Payout Schedule will be used. The division of the purse will be 30% to 1<sup>st</sup> Go; 30% to 2<sup>nd</sup> Go and 40% to the average.
3. You may enter as many horses as you wish. **Youth and Senior contestants may roll their times from the Open class, this MUST BE declared at entry- no changes will be allowed after check in!**
4. PeeWee Contestants may NOT enter the youth or open classes and must be 10 & under. PeeWees must have competed in three district jackpots to qualify for Finals.
5. Exhibitions are individual runs, but will be run in time blocks with a limited number of spots available. Tickets will be given for each time block, and are valid ONLY for that block.
6. Entries must be postmarked by August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Late entries will be accepted until 11:00am on August 31<sup>st</sup>. There will be a fee of \$20.00 late charge for the convenience. DO NOT MAIL LATE ENTRIES!
7. Horse substitutions will be allowed, but must be declared at check-in and before the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> Go.
8. No refunds- unless you have a valid vet release prior to check in at the Finals. No rider substitutions allowed.
9. **All Contestants MUST CHECK IN on Saturday, August 31st between 9:00am & 11:00am**
10. Prizes will be given to the top 4 in each open and youth division, and the top 2 in each division in the senior class- in addition to added money for both go-rounds and the average. Prizes must be picked up, checks will be mailed.
11. **\*\*NEW FOR 2019- BOTH rounds will be random draw.**
12. Any contestant losing their hat during their run will be charged \$5.00, payable at the end of that class.

13. Dress code: **FULL WESTERN ATTIRE** is required. This includes: **long sleeve western shirt with collar and button down, jeans, boots and hat or helmet.** Shirt sleeves must be rolled down and buttoned or snapped. Shirt tails must be tucked in. Vests are optional. No riding shoes allowed. In the interest of safety, contestants may wear appropriate riding helmets.
14. All advertising must have the approval of the ND NBHA State Director.
15. NBHA Rules apply. Any questions or disputes that may arise will be settled by the State Director, whose decision will be final.
16. To help cover costs associated with moving the State Finals indoors, each contestant will be charged a \$25 State Finals Arena Fee in addition to the original \$20 processing fee.

Volunteers Needed:

Volunteers are needed from all districts to help with setting of barrels, running of gates, etc. during exhibitions as well as the Finals Jackpot. Sign up sheet will be available at check in. Gate: ND01, Barrel 1: ND02, Barrel 2: ND03, Barrel 3: ND04, Float/ Fill: ND05. Please contact Lois at 701-652-2413 or 701-307-0467 if you are interested in helping out! THANK YOU!

Stalls: Available at the NDWS building for \$25 per night (Friday and Saturday nights). Stalls are mandatory for all horses competing- NO setting up pens and NO overnight tie outs allowed! One bag of shavings is provided with each stall purchased. If you would like additional shavings, they are available at \$7.50 per bag. **STALL FORMS ARE MAILED SEPARATE FROM ENTRIES, SEE MAILING INFORMATION ON STALL FORM!!**

Electrical Hookups: Reserved electrical hookup sites will be assigned on a first come, first served basis at \$25 per night. You will be issued a refund if the hookups are filled prior to receiving your entry. Electrical hookups are reserved on the stall form.
